Please complete the application form at the back of this booklet to be considered for this scholarship.

The deadline for receipt of all application materials by The Lodi Arts Project Fund, or postmark in the U.S. mail, is **March 27, 2009**. You must submit the original plus three copies (four total) of the application materials you are asked to prepare (the cover sheet, statement about intellectual/academic interests, transcript, etc.).

We will duplicate all confidential letters of recommendation that faculty write on your behalf. Awards will be made for the 2009-10 academic year. Half the amount of the total award will be paid in each semester of the academic year. Scholarship recipients may receive funds from only one scholarship awarded by the Lodi Arts Project Fund during that academic year. To receive your award, you must register as a full-time English Major each semester of the award year.

All scholarships offered are intended only for students who intend to receive their B.A. degree with a Major in English Literature or Creative Writing.

About the JH Memorial Scholarship

This scholarship of approximately \$500 is awarded to a graduating high school senior from within the boundaries of the Lodi Unified School District. Applicants must be enrolled full-time as an English major at an accredited university or college. Students do not need to be eligible for financial aid; however, financial need may be taken into account.

Established in the 2003-04 academic year, JH Scholarships are made possible by an endowment established in honor of Jim Harvey's literary contributions to the Lodi community. The endowment is intended to foster and support student excellence in undergraduate education in English and Creative Writing.

Jim Harvey Memorial Literary Scholarship

Scholarship applicants must submit the following:

1. A letter describing academic goals
2. An official high school transcript
3. Résumé of extracurricular activities
4. A writing sample of 6-8 pages of poetry or prose
5. Two letters of recommendation written by faculty members

Proof of registration at an accredited college or university

Recipients will be offered the opportunity to work as in intern with the Lodi Arts Commission depending on their interests.
